The event included numerous family activities: a free Santa Photo Booth, drumming with Santa, a Bottle Cap Table with prizes, a Craft Table with the Western Quebec Literacy Council (WQLC), a chilli, pulled pork and hot dog Lunch, as well as a bake table. In the afternoon, we welcomed the WQLC, the Regional Association of Western Quebecers and Connexions Resource Centre, who shared information about their organization and hosted crafting and literacy-based games and a Literacy Kit and Book Giveaway.
